Apollonios of Tyana -

Life of Apollonius

Pythagoras had existed in the age when Troy was fighting about Helen, and he had been the fairest of the sons of Panthus, and the best equipped of them all, yet he died at so young an age, as to excite the lamentations even of Homer.

Well after that **Pythagoras** passed into several bodies according to the decree of **Adrastea** [a goddess of justice] which transfers the soul from body to body, and then he again resumed the form of man, and was born to Mnesarchides of Samos, **this time a sage instead of a barbarian**, and an Ionian instead of a Trojan, and so immune from death that he did not even forget that he was Euphorbos.

It is in this way that individual human souls in the present experience the sense of heritage with individuals in the past. Within their souls there is a "reincarnation" of the spirit of a mission and purpose begun long ago and to be carried on by them. When a child is born—whether in a slum and destitute, or in a palace and of royal birth—it lives because the Lord has breathed the breath of life into it.

The Lord our God has **created another individual soul in that baby**. Would it not then be more precise to speak **not of the embodiment** of **the Logos** in the person of **Jesus Christos**, but of **the Logos's expression** in **Jesus** through the medium of the great God-born monad that is the Planetary Logos of the Earth? We call **Christ** the Word. But a **speaker doesn't, after all, take shape in a word** but expresses himself or herself through it. Similarly, **God is expressed, not embodied, in Christ**. It is in that sense that **Christ** is in truth the Word of God, and thus yet another **stumbling block** to reconciling Christianity and certain other religious movements disappears.
